S.W.I.N.G. Scholarship Criteria and Requirements



Applicant must:

- 1. Be female.
- 2. Be a woman of color.
- 3. Be currently enrolled as a full-time student at a nationally accredited institution of higher education (i.e. college, university, or technical institute) for the upcoming 2020-2021 school year.
- 4. Have a grade point average of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale.
- 5. Have rendered service in their community during the 2019-2020 school year.
- 6. Submit a sealed and most recent official transcript from institution of attendance.
- 7. Complete and submit a SWING Scholarship application.
- 8. Submit a resume that includes professional objective, extracurricular activities, and community service involvement (please include a summary of what you do for the community service project and include references, non-relatives)
- 9. Submit a photo dressed in professional attire. Please no "selfies." If you need guidance, please see attachment.
- 10. Submit one letter of recommendation from a faculty member at the current school of attendance on school letterhead.
- 11. Submit one letter of recommendation from any other person of your choice (may not be a family member).
- 12. Submit a biographical outline, including reasons for pursuing your educational program (maximum of 2 pages typed, Times New Roman font, size 12).
- 13. Submit a 1-page, single-spaced essay which answers the question, "How do you envision living the legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. in 2020 and how are you working towards exceeding that vision?"
- 14. Submit a 1-page, single-spaced essay which answers the question, "How will the lessons you have learned throughout your educational experiences positively influence the growth and development of your family, community, and yourself?"

Note: All documentation submitted must be typed.

All requested documents and information must be submitted on or before July 31, 2020. If sent by postal mail, documents and information must be postmarked by July 28, 2020.

Professional Photo Submission-

It is important when submitting a professional photo that you make sure everything is just right. You should be dressed in business professional attire, preferably a dark colored dress with stockings or suit/slacks with a white or blue button up shirt avoiding any display of cleavage. It is recommended that you wear small stud earrings, only one modest necklace if worn, and one ring per hand with neutral colored fingernail polish if they are shown in the photo.

It is strongly suggested that you photograph from the waist up. Refrain from throwing up any hand signs or having any other items or people in your picture. Your photo should be taken in a well-lit area with a neutral background and show your full face. Lastly, find someone else to take the photo for you. Avoid using a selfie or a reflection in the mirror. Knowing how to submit a professional photo can make or break your chances on any application or job opportunity.
